

## Multiple Environmental Government Acquisition (MEGA)



**Background:** The USACE Multiple Environmental Government Acquisition (MEGA) Program is a \$7 Billion, 10-year strategy to simplify the procurement of environmental services. The USACE Omaha District is leading the program with other USACE districts throughout the west having the ability to leverage the acquisition strategy. The MEGA program has a significant small business component for both set-aside competitions and large business use of small businesses. With this program, the USACE will streamline the acquisition process for environmental services in a manner that supports small business growth.

**Capabilities:** PWT is an environmental remediation services small business with ongoing clean-up operations throughout the Western U.S. PWT's capabilities provide USACE with a valued partner to accomplish environmental remediation in a cost effective, low risk manner.

**Remedial Action Contract 2, EPA, \$232 Million, 12/2006 - 12/2016.** PWT is the prime contractor for this ID/IQ contract providing a full suite of Superfund environmental remediation services to include investigations, remedial design / remedial actions, construction, and community involvement. In the performance of this contract, PWT developed and implemented a Program Management System to effectively manage concurrent task orders across the Western U.S. This proven system has allowed PWT to execute work at 22 sites in 5 states. PWT's Quality Management System provides the necessary project controls to deliver high quality services on

time and within budget. The EPA has recognized PWT's high quality service through annual evaluations of 'Excellent' and 'Outstanding' ratings.

**Denver Federal Center, GSA, \$6.5 Million, 12/2003 - 11/2012.** PWT provides environmental services including asbestos in the soil and community involvement. PWT's engineers and scientists manage subcontractor performance of asbestos removal and mitigation activities. The site is located adjacent to residential neighborhoods and schools and so requires a robust, active community involvement plan.

**Rocky Mountain Arsenal (RMA), EPA, \$17.3 Million, 4/2003 - 4/2013.** PWT provides engineering consulting services that support the remediation of RMA. The site initially covered 27 square miles and involved over 600 contaminants, military munitions, unique chemical warfare agents, and pesticides. PWT provided technical engineering services to include innovative landfill cap and cover designs.
